Subject: Proposed Repeal or Amendment to ByLaws

In accordance with National Bylaws and administrative procedures,
Article Eight (8), Section 800, the following is submitted for consideration
by the body assembled at the National Convention.

Article IV Shoulder Patches. Paragraph C

Current ByLaws read; At the wearer's choice; if a member is a member of the Military Order of Devil Dogs, the MODD Patch may be worn in place of the United States Flag patch, centered on the right sleeve and 1-1/2" below the shoulder seam.

I submit that this paragraph should be repealed, or amended to read as follows;

At the wearer's choice; If a member is a member of the Military Order of Devil Dogs and they choose to wear the MODD patch on the right sleeve, it shall be placed beneath and centered on the American Flag patch above it.

Rational: The flag of the United States Of America should never be replaced, or

put in a secondary position to any military or organizational symbol,
