The Central Division Department Commandants have been busy with tasks outlined in the Board of Trustees meetings and since this past National Mid-Winter. They have been working diligently making sure the detachments of the Central Division are in compliance with their 990's, Corporate non-profit status, making sure that all detachments have the same fiscal year and if they don't then point them towards our COO Bob Borka to help with a letter sent to the IRS on their behalf.

I have to date been to all six Departments since last year's National Convention and have had two conference calls with all the Departments to outline items that each department should be working on to move forward. Each Department has established a Marine for Life liaison in their departments and are working with the local reps now.
