 Subject: Proposed Administrative Procedure Change

In accordance with **Section 1100, National Bylaw Amendments** I am submitting the following change.

## CURRENT:

**Section 810. Bylaws and Administrative Procedures.** A Department Convention shall adopt Department Bylaws and may adopt Administrative Procedures which are consistent with the National Charter, the National Bylaws, and National Administrative Procedures, provided they have been approved by the National Judge Advocate and are on file at National Headquarters.

## PROPOSED:

**Section 810. Bylaws and Administrative Procedures.** A Department Convention shall adopt Department Bylaws and may adopt Administrative Procedures which are consistent with the National Charter, the National Bylaws, and National Administrative Procedures, provided they have been approved by the National Judge Advocate and are on file at National Headquarters. From time to time the Department Bylaws need to be revised, amended, or repealed. To revise, amend, or repeal the Department Bylaws all Department Members must be notified at least 60 days prior to voting on the revision, amendment, or repeal. Notification must include the revision, amendment or repeal and may be made via regular mail, Department newsletter, posting on the Department website or by other electronic means.

## RATIONAL:

There is no requirement that anyone must be notified of any revision, amendment or repeal of the Department Bylaws or Administrative Procedures. This sets a minimum requirement to notify the membership.
