 Subject: Proposed Administrative Procedure Change

In accordance with **Section 1100. National Bylaw Amendments** I am submitting the following change.

CURRENT:

Section 905. Bylaws. Each detachment shall adopt bylaws and may adopt administrative procedures that are consistent with the Department and National Bylaws and Administrative Procedures. The bylaws and administrative procedures shall be approved by the Department Judge Advocate. In the absence of a jurisdictional department, the National Judge Advocate shall be the approving authority.

PROPOSED:

Section 905. Bylaws and Administrative Procedures. Each Detachment shall adopt bylaws and may adopt administrative procedures that are consistent with the Department and National Bylaws and Administrative Procedures. These Detachment Bylaws and Administrative Procedures shall be approved by the Department Judge Advocate. In the absence of a jurisdictional department, the National Judge Advocate shall be the approving authority. From time to time the Detachment Bylaws need to be revised, amended, or repealed. To revise, amend, or repeal the Detachment Bylaws all Detachment Members must be notified at least 60 days prior to voting on the revision, amendment, or repeal. Notification must include the revision, amendment or repeal and may be made via regular mail, Detachment newsletter, posting on the Detachment website or by other electronic means.

RATIONAL:

There is no requirement that anyone must be notified of any revision, amendment or repeal of the Detachment Bylaws or Administrative Procedures prior to voting on the revision, amendment, or repeal. This sets a minimum requirement to notify the Detachment membership prior to voting on the revision, amendment, or repeal.
