Current Uniform Code for the Female Undress Uniforms, Long and Short Sleeve, and the Female Casual Red Blazer Uniform regarding the wearing of hose:

- Hose, nylon, black (with pumps) or socks, black, (with trousers.)

Proposed Change :

- Hose, nylon, flesh tone (with pumps) or socks, black (with trousers.)

Rationale:

The Marine Corps Uniform Regulations dated 01 May 2018 state that female Marines who opt to wear the uniform skirt for daytime or casual events, must wear flesh tone hose. As a recruit in 1988, I was taught that females should wear hose that most closely matched their natural skin tone. The reason behind the regulation was so that female Marines would project a more natural appearance. The 2018 regulations state that black hose are required only for formal or black-tie events. It is my opinion that changing the Marine Corps League Uniform Code is in keeping with the history and traditions of the Marine Corps.
