

During this Quarter I have attended all mandated Board of Trustees meetings as scheduled by National.

- Modern Day Marine was held virtually, while the experience of walking around the displays and set ups was not quite the same, watching the videos of the capabilities and the new tech that is available to our Marines is awesome!
- PLM Reports have been completed. NY and NJ and PA had 100% compliance, with one PLM issue (PA Det. #726) being resolved.
- The 990 Reports, check with your detachments to see that they are completed. Reach out to those that are having issues or are not in compliance and need to be reinstated. The form to use is the IRS Form 1024-A.
- National Commandant charged me with the task of creating a Leadership presentation for Department Staff. Seventy-nine officers were in attendance.
- Mid-Winter Conference was virtual this year and as with everything, was a unique experience.
- Changed the date for the Northeast Division Conference from April 23-24, 2021 to June 4-5, 2021. Guest speakers are: Col. Philip N. Ash, 1st Marine Corps Recruiting District from Garden City, Long Island and Wilson Lee, Deputy Director from Young Marines. Presentation of the colors was performed by the Capital Area PA Young Marine.
- Received Division Scouting Report from Marine Timothy Daudelin with the following information:
 - NJ reported 38 Eagle Scouts
 - NY reported 24 Eagle Scouts
 - PA – No information provided.
- Received and passed out the membership awards to the Department Commandants
- The Department of NJ ran their 19th Leadership School which was held via Zoom.
- The Department of PA ran their first Leadership School under the Direction of Commandant Ziltz. It was held at the Department Headquarters in Ft. Indiantown Gap, PA.
- Attended the Major Samuel Nicholas Memorial Ceremony in Philadelphia, PA on Sunday May 23, 2021.

- The Social Media master list has been compiled and submitted to the National Commandant
 - NY: 62 Detachments: 54 have websites, 35 have Facebook/Twitter/Instagram Accounts or a combination of both
 - NJ: 35 Detachments: 3 have websites, 25 have Facebook/Twitter/Instagram Accounts or a combination thereof
 - PA: 65 Detachment: 23 have websites, 42 have Facebook pages.
- TACOM Rifle Inventory has been disseminated. A recommendation is to appoint one individual as the Department Armor to keep a running record for each detachment with rifles. They should be the ones submitting the report to the Department Commandants and up to the Division. Regarding the inventory, the Departments of NY & PA have completed their data collection. I would like to have your completed lists in July. If it is not complete, send in what you do have on record.
- This year we know that the number for Honor Guard Stats are skewed. As we move through the pandemic, we should be collecting a more accurate data.
- Attended the Major Samuel Nicholas Memorial Ceremonies on 23 May 2021 & 4 July 2021
