Subj: Southern Division Homeless Veterans Report

1. The Southern Division does have active Departments that are teaming with the Disabled American Veterans , Veterans Administration in Arkansas and Veterans of Foreign Wars organizations in assisting with Homeless Veterans.
2. The Department of Arkansas Detachments are teaming with the DAV, Sporting groups and churches in providing health and comfort care items, toiletry items, food items, and counseling sessions with the University of Central Arkansas through the Veterans Service Officer who is a Marine Corps League member.
3. The Northwest Arkansas Detachment is teaming with local Veterans organizations in assisting Homeless Veterans with health and care items, food items, homeless shelters and future opportunities. Northwest Arkansas is in the process of seeking funding from local and State Government for financial assistance for Homeless Veterans needs.
4. The Department of Oklahoma Detachments are active in Homeless Veterans assistance. The Sooner Detachment in Oklahoma City is currently working with Air Force homeless veterans. The Schwab Detachment in Tulsa is starting relationship with homeless shelters in assisting homeless veterans.
