ANNUAL REPORT NORTHEAST DIVISION

The Northeast Division serves three Departments and a total of one hundred and sixty detachments. The 2021-2022 FY began with the election of current Division Vice and Assistant Division Vice Commandants who will continue to serve in this capacity until August of 2023 when the next elections will take place.

Department meetings are being conducted as scheduled and the work at hand is making progress.

Our overall membership is holding steady at 80% strength, having over ten-thousand members. This is still a concern whereas we need to reach out more to those detachments who have members in arrears.

During the year the Division as a whole has made great strides despite some of the restrictions that continue to remain in place. We have reported over 500 Honor Guard Funeral Services in addition to presenting two-hundred and thirty-four Eagle Scouts with Good Citizenship Awards.

All of the Departments have reported in regarding the PLM Reports and IRS 990s. These are areas that also need to be monitored as there was no single Department who has reached 100% in either. The 990s are of major concern as less than 50% of the Division is reporting having sent them in.

The Division has also seen its share of misfortune whereas the Department of NY has reported four Detachments having had their charters suspended or surrendered. The Department of PA is in the process of closing down five inactive Detachments while the Department of NJ was able to revive a Detachment that had voluntarily surrendered their charter but since has become active again.

As a Division, our largest program has been the Toys for Tots. According to the report received, there were over Three-Million toys collected; each Department collecting over One-Million each and served 1,463,126 families in total.

All of the Departments are currently on track to complete their Installation of Officers for the upcoming year and have their Conventions already scheduled.
