Subject: Proposed Administrative Procedure Change

In accordance with **Section 10020. Amendments** of the **National Administrative Procedures** I am submitting the following change.

CURRENT:

NOTE 1

For each additional medal award, a bronze star will be worn. A silver star will be worn in place of five (5) bronze stars and a gold star will be worn in place of five (5) silver stars unless otherwise noted. The exceptions are: Distinguished Citizens Medal - Gold; Distinguished Citizens Medal - Silver; Distinguished Citizens Medal - Bronze; and Distinguished Service Medal. On each of the aforementioned Distinguished Service Medals a 5/16" gold star will be worn to indicate additional awards and a 5/16" silver star will be worn in place of five (5) gold stars.

PROPOSED:

NOTE 1

For each additional medal, ribbon, or commendation award, a 3/16" bronze star will be worn. A 3/16" silver star will be worn in place of five (5) 3/16" bronze stars and a 3/16" gold star will be worn in place of five (5) 3/16" silver stars unless otherwise noted. The exceptions are the Heroism Medal and Ribbon, Distinguished Citizens Medals and Ribbons and the Distinguished Service Medal and Ribbon on which a 5/16" gold star will be worn to indicate additional awards and a 5/16" silver star will be worn in place of five (5) 5/16" gold stars.

RATIONAL:

Make clear which size stars belong to with Medal or Ribbon.
