Subj: Proposed National Administrative Procedures Change

In accordance with National Administrative Procedures, Chapter Ten, Section 10020 the following proposed amendment is submitted for consideration by the body assembled at the National Convention.

PROPOSED:

Amend Chapter Six, Section 6000 d., of the National Administrative Procedures by striking the words, "by each member" in the first sentence, and inserting the words "only by those members."

Amend Chapter Six, Section 6000 d by inserting the following sentence following the first sentence, "Those members therefore, shall be identified as Charter Members."

Currently the wording of Section 6000 d, reads: "Each new Charter, before framing, shall be signed by each member who signed the charter application."

The amended Section 6000 d will read: "Each new Charter before framing, shall be signed only by those members who signed the Charter Application. Those members therefore, shall be identified as Charter Members."

Rational: As the current wording is apparently open to more than one interpretation by some as to who also may sign the Charter.

To identify those who rightly should be permitted to sign the Charter; those members who initiated and founded a new Detachment of the Marine Corps League, and no one else. Therefore, should be so recognized as the Charter Members of the Detachment.
