The goal presented at the Midwest Conference, 2022-2023 Fiscal Year was for Marine Corps League Department and Detachment Forms and Functions to be emphasized with timely compliance.

Implementation and compliance are crucial because it transforms plans and strategies into actionable steps and follow-ups. The importance of implementation lies in several key aspects:

Turning Vision into Reality: Implementation is the bridge that connects the organization's vision and goals to real-world actions. Without effective implementation, ideas remain just concepts without tangible outcomes.

The Midwest Division developed a Leadership Resource website for Commandants to help run their businesses. A Department and a Detachment are individual business units with new leadership elected yearly.

Secondly, the Midwest Division created a new Division level position, Chief of Staff Compliance, to monitor and assist Departments and Detachments. The results were very positive.
