3. STATUS:

- a. The current Edition of the Recruiting, Retention, and Marketing guidebook is up-to-date, and we have no changes currently.

3. Topics/Discussion:

- e. <u>New Member</u>: New members, several MCL members offered to be on the committee, Antonio Chapa, Frank Menard. Are we okay with the size of our group? Or are we willing to accept new members?
- f. <u>First Timer Meet and Greet:</u> First Timers meet and greet at the National Convention in Palm Springs. The following ideas were discussed:
 - i. Membership committee members could canvass the check in line and promote the 1st Timers brief and welcome them aboard.
 - ii. We agreed to put a request in to the Public Relations committee to put us on the monthly Scuttlebutt in June 2024 to give a brief to newcomers and what to expect at the National convention.
- g. New templates: Matt Lyman developed several templates for our use for IG stories/reels and IG grid posts. Discussed how to move forward with the templates provided by Matt. Chairman to forward the templates to Jason House for review and how to implement them. (Templates forwarded to Jason 10/30/2023)
- h. FB Membership Group: Discussed the current membership group and the lack of new members joining the group. Discussed ways of reaching out to MCL members to join the group. Examples are to share the link with friends, detachments, and other veteran groups.
