 Subj: Amendment of National Administrative Procedures.

In accordance with the Reference, the below Amendment to the National Administrative Procedures is proposed.

---

Amend Section X. [pp AP Enclosure (3) – 6] of Enclosure 3 as follows

**1. Delete the NOTE:/last sentence of Section X.**

*Current Wording:*

**X. MEDALLIONS**

Marine of the Year or Associate Member of the Year medallion and ribbon (national, division, department or detachment); the Chapel of Four Chaplains Medallion (Legion of Merit, Humanitarian Award, and Bronze Medallion Award); the Chief's Badge of Office, the Past Chief Devil Dog Collar, or the Military Order of Devil Dogs collar, if authorized, may be worn with the RED BLAZER CASUAL UNIFORM, RED BLAZER FORMAL UNIFORM, THE EVENING DRESS UNIFORM, OR THE UNDRRESS UNIFORMS (MALE AND FEMALE). Only one of these devices, medallions, or collars, may be worn at a time at the option of the wearer. **~~NOTE—MEDALLIONS MAY NOT BE WORN WITH ANY OTHER STYLE SHIRT (I.E., POLO, T-SHIRT, OR CIVILIAN DRESS SHIRTS.) (Rev 2022)~~**

*Proposed Wording as follows:*

**X. MEDALLIONS**

Marine of the Year or Associate Member of the Year medallion and ribbon (National, Division, Department or Detachment); the Chapel of Four Chaplains Medallion (Legion of Merit, Humanitarian Award, and Bronze Medallion Award); the Chief's Badge of Office, the Past Chief Devil Dog Collar, the Military Order of Devil Dogs collar, if authorized, may be worn with the RED BLAZER CASUAL UNIFORM, RED BLAZER FORMAL UNIFORM, THE EVENING DRESS UNIFORM, OR THE UNDRRESS UNIFORMS (MALE AND FEMALE). Only one of these devices, medallions, or collars, may be worn at a time at the option of the wearer.

**2. Additional Deletions.**

There are nine (9) additional instances in Section X of Enclosure (3) appearing on pp 8, 9, 10, 12, 13, 14, and 15 where a modified version of this statement appears, each addressing a single authorized uniform (i.e. Male and Female Undress, Casual, etc.) Each has the same NOTE/Last Sentence. The same deletion will apply to each of these nine (9) instances to avoid conflict and inconsistency.

**3. Rational:**


Several examples may be cited where these prohibitions would be in conflict with the accepted wearing and/or display of specific awards presented to individuals. One example is the Department of Defense authorization

*Once a Marine, Always a Marine*

**OVER**

allowing individual recipients to wear the Miniature Medals that represent their awards on Civilian Formal Attire. We would presumptuous to try to regulate how the recipients wear the Chapel of the Four Chaplains awards. Likewise, subsidiarity organizations such as the Marine Corps League Auxiliary and the Military Order of the Devil Dogs are recognized as separate entities operating under their own Bylaws.
