MARINE CORPS LEAGUE CONVENTION AWARDS

The Awards Committee recommends change to the 2025 National Administrative Procedures Enclosure (4), section: Marine Corps League Convention Awards, article: National Convention Streamers

The current directive reads:

NATIONAL CONVENTION STREAMERS

These will be awarded to those detachments, departments and divisions who display the League standards at the National Convention and will be in the color of the state in which the National Convention is being held with appropriate lettering.

The recommended change to read:

NATIONAL CONVENTION STREAMERS

The streamers are to be awarded to those detachments, departments and divisions who attend the National Convention as properly registered delegates. The streamers will be in a color to be determined by the state in which the National Convention is being held, with appropriate lettering and year date.

Rationale ... The requirement for the attending detachments, departments, or divisions to have their League standards present and displayed at the National Convention in order to receive an attendance streamer was removed by Past National Commandant Richard Gore verbally at the 94th National Convention, held in Overland Park, Kansas. 2017. He cited that it was a burden to travel with these bulky items and the potential damage and/or loss of them. The National Administrative Procedures were never updated to reflect this change.
